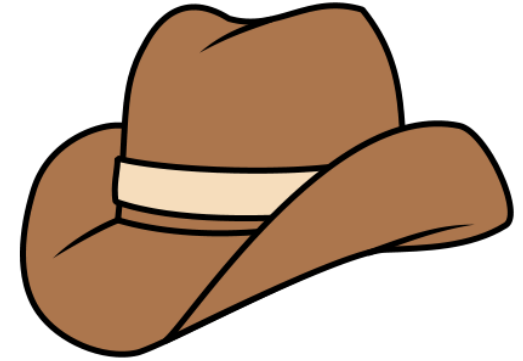


Agenda Tonight

» Start and End Time

- > School starts at 8:00 and ends 3:15 p.m. M-Th
- > 4 Day/week school year next year
- > Students gather on the playground starting as early as 7:30 a.m. until 7:55 a.m. and are led into class at that time by the teacher/aide

» Absences

- > Students who will be absent please contact Linda in the office ASAP
- > Students who miss more than 10 days per semester may lose credit

» Drop off/Pick Up

- > If you drop off and pick up please park as far down the row as possible so as to not block traffic

» Bus Policy

- > If your child is the only member of the family riding the bus we ask that a parent/guardian be at the bus stop waiting for your child or they will be brought back to school and phone call made
- > Linda will have sign up sheets ready at K assessments
