Yavapai County School Superintendent Tim Carter is pleased to announce the appointment of **Mrs. Teresa Price to the Bagdad Unified School District Governing Board**. The appointment will be effective upon taking the oath of office, Tuesday, September 5, 2017 and will conclude on December 31, 2018. The vacancy was created by the resignation of Board Member Tracie Loveall, who took a position working for the school district. The service provided to the District by Mrs. Loveall is greatly appreciated.

Mrs. Price attended Washington High School in Phoenix, Arizona prior to enrolling at Penn Foster College for an Associate of Arts Degree in Accounting and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Management.

Mrs. Price is married and has lived in Bagdad for two (2) years, where she currently works for FMI in the Human Resources Department. Her husband works for FMI as well and the couple has two grown children in the Denver area.

Many people in the community will know her as a volunteer at the Bagdad Library, and through her work at the Dental Clinic. Prior to moving to Bagdad, she worked for the Humboldt and Globe Unified School Districts in various positions in accounting, student enrollment and attendance, and human resources for about twenty (20) years.

Prior to making the appointment, Mr. Carter reviewed the letters of interest and resumes received. He interviewed those who applied on Wednesday, August 30th. He then spoke with each currently seated Governing Board Member and administrative leaders to receive their feedback.

Superintendent Carter stated that "Mrs. Price is familiar with the operations of a school district. She has a wealth of experience working with Governing Boards, administrations, teachers, parents and students. She is

a solid proponent of a strong public educational system and should be a resource to her fellow Board Members. I believe she will represent the voters of the Bagdad School District very well. Her experience as a parent will be a benefit as she carries out her new responsibilities”.
