Yavapai County School Superintendent Tim Carter is pleased to announce the appointment of **Mrs. Natalie Webber, to the Bagdad Unified School District Governing Board.** The appointment will be effective October 2, 2018 and will expire on December 31, 2020. This seat was vacant due to the fact that Board Member Mikaela Gist, resigned to accept employment with the school district, making her ineligible to continue on the Board. We appreciate the efforts Mrs. Gist put forward while a member of the Governing Board.

Mrs. Webber has been a resident of the district since April 2017. She graduated from Snowflake High School in Snowflake, Arizona and holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science, from Hiram College in Ohio and a Master of Science and Social Administration Degree from Case Western Reserve University, in Ohio.
